One Year Plan:

Within the next year, CCFD will have 90% of all firefighting staff certified to Pro-Board Haz-Mat Awareness and Operations as well as Firefighter I. All fire line officers are familiar with and using Firehouse Software to enter all training, calls and activities.

Two Year Plan:

Within the next two years, CCFD will have 80% of all firefighting staff certified to Basic Vehicle Rescue: Technician and Pro-Board Firefighter II. All fire line officers have a minimum of 32 hours officer or leadership training.

Five Year Plan:

Within the next five years, 90% of all active Chauffeurs will be certified to Pro-Board Pumper Operator and/or Ariel Operator. CCFD will have 100 active firefighting staff and officers, maintaining 90% at Firefighter I, 80% at Firefighter II and all chief officers have Pro-Board Officer I & II.
