

004 – SEATBELT POLICY

Policy Title: Seatbelt Policy (Old Policy #2)

Policy Effective Date: 6 July 2009

Policy Revised Date: 2 January 2012, 23:59

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to insure that all firefighting personnel responding to emergencies with CCFD apparatus are properly seated and wearing safety belts whenever department apparatus is in motion. It is the sole responsibility of each member or parent or guardian to insure that safety restraints are used at all times.

Policy:

All CCFD firefighting personnel and support staff as well as any other passengers must be seated at all times and wearing proper seatbelts or safety restraints whenever department apparatus is in motion. There are no exceptions to this policy at any time and it shall be the responsibility of parents or guardians of under-aged children to insure that they are properly seated at all times and wearing safety restraints.

Procedures:

The associated procedures and guidelines relating to this policy may be found in the CCFD Standard Operating Guidelines & Procedures under section 403.02 – Persons Riding in Motorized Vehicles.
